City Manager Josh Nelson provided a staff report and spoke about the rain event in early December 2023, where emergency work was necessary at Tonner Canyon because the roadway collapsed and became impassable. Adopting this resolution would allow the City Manager to immediately procure any necessary equipment, services and supplies for an emergency without engaging in the competitive bidding process.

Mayor Moss announced she had received a speaker card from Samual B.V. to speak on this subject for one minute.

Samuel B.V. said he was a resident in this area adjacent to the City of Industry. He said he had concerns about the decision to hire a contractor without a bidding process. This area is surrounded by other communities and felt it was important to avail all the communities in this competitive bidding process. He then urged the Council not to sign this resolution.

Assistant City Manager Bing Hyun provided a staff report and stated that the City incurred expenses due to road and culvert damages at Tonner Canyon, damage due to flooding in the pumphouse of Gale Avenue and Azusa, and roof leaks at the Expo Center Pavilion because of the major disaster, and those cost are eligible for FEMA and Cal OES financial assistance. To begin processing a request for public assistance, the City Council must designate City agents responsible for providing required assurances and executing agreements with FEMA and Cal OES on behalf of the City. City Staff recommends that the form designate agents by position, instead of specific names and recommends the City Council designate City Manager and Assistant City Manager as the City's agents.
