SUBJECT: Walnut Valley Water District Invoice for Grand Avenue between Baker

Parkway and 60 Freeway Project (MP 99-31 #16) ROPS Line Item No.

Attached for your consideration is an invoice from Walnut Valley Water District (WVWD) for the Phase II hydraulic analysis for the Industry Business Center (IBC) project including the review of the water distribution system and pipe diameters, the IBC demands, location and size of the proposed recycled water tank, booster pump sizing and potential site booster pump station, and detailed modeling of the overall recycled water system and impacts of the IBC project to the system, in accordance with District rules and regulations. The Cost Estimate for the completion of the work described above is \$50,800.00 and was approved on the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule under Line Item No. 205.

In July of 2015, the Successor Agency approved a Water Service Availability Letter from WWWD. This letter identified the required potable and recycled water facilities and improvements for WVWD to service the IBC Development. The list includes: a two million gallon recycled water reservoir, a booster pump station, approximately 24,000 linear feet of recycled water pipelines, 18,000 linear feet of potable water pipelines, and fire hydrants.

Staff has provided WVWD with a schedule for projected daily usage for the next five years. Using this information, WVWD will now perform the next phase of the hydraulic modeling intended to calibrate and fine tune the entire recycled water distribution system to be installed for the IBC development.

It is recommended that the Board approve the expenditure in the amount of \$50,800.00 and authorize the issuance of a special check prior to June 30, 2016 for the same amount. Please forward the signed document to Alicia Fernandez with CNC Engineering for further processing.
