Subject: Second Public Access Tour of Tres Hermanos Ranch Recap

Recommendation:

Receive an update on the second public access tour of Tres Hermanos Ranch.

Background/Analysis:

On September 23, 2023, the cities of Chino Hills, Diamond Bar, and City of Industry hosted four chaperoned tours of the Tres Hermanos Ranch (Ranch). The tours, free for the public, were conducted to provide insight into the Ranch's history, operations, and natural environment. The event began at the Diamond Bar Center, where participants boarded shuttles that transported them to the Ranch. The tour included three stops: Arnold Reservoir, the barn/residence, and an area showcasing local plants and animals. The tour lasted approximately 1.5 hours and was attended by 98 participants, guided by key personnel, including City Managers from the three cities.

Due to the overwhelming interest in the initial event, with over 400 registrations and only 98 available spots, a waiting list was developed. This high demand prompted discussions among the Tres Hermanos Conservation Authority (Authority), resulting in the organization of an additional public tour on June 15, 2024, to accommodate those on the waitlist. At the March 13, 2024, board meeting, it was also decided to reimburse the staffing costs incurred by each city in support of the Ranch tours. The budget for these essential support functions, including participant registration, shuttle coordination, site preparation, supervised property access, and clean-up, was set at \$10,000 per tour.

On June 15, 2024, the second set of tours followed the same process as the initial event, with participants checking in at the Diamond Bar Center and shuttles departing between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Each participant received a commemorative bag and pin featuring the Authority logo, along with water and snacks. Of those left on the waitlist, 80 were able to participate in the second tour. Additional security was provided by volunteers from the City of Chino Hills Citizens on Patrol program.

The costs for the second tour were as follows:

Future Ranch Tours are scheduled to be held twice a year. Staff will schedule the next tour this fall. There are approximately 125 individuals remaining on the original waitlist. Once the tour date has been determined, staff will contact individuals from the waitlist and fill any remaining seats as needed. Staff expects to retire the original waitlist after the fall tour.

Fiscal Impact:

Executive Director

The Authority's Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget did not specifically allocate funds for the Ranch Tour; however, sufficient funding from other program areas covered the \$7,345.60 cost of the second tour. Two Ranch tours have been included in the approved 2024-25 Fiscal Year budget.
