

SUBJECT:

Proposed amendment of Section 2.6 entitled Commission General

Counsel of the Industry Public Utilities Commission By-Laws.

Section 5.1 Amendments to By-Laws authorizes the Commission to amend the By-Laws by a majority vote of the Commission.

As the Commission retains additional legal counsel, it would be in order to amend Section 2.6 Commission General Counsel to read as follows:

Section 2.6 <u>Commission General Counsel.</u> The Commission's General Counsel shall be the person who is the City Attorney for the City, <u>or other legal counsel so appointed by the Commission.</u> The General Counsel shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission and shall be responsible for all legal affairs of the Commission. The General Counsel shall prepare or approve as to form all legal documents and instruments required to transact Commission business and shall represent the Commission in all legal matters and proceedings.

IT IS RECOMMENDED

That the Commission adopt Section 2.6 <u>Commission General Counsel</u> with the added language: "or other legal counsel so appointed by the Commission".
