Subject: City of Industry - Stormwater Inspection Program

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board has issued a New Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit (Board Order R4-2012-0175) to 84 cities within Los Angeles County. This permit requires each city to improve the quality of water that enters into storm water collection systems. Focusing on water quality will control the amount of pollution to our groundwater basin, the San Jose Creek, the San Gabriel River and the ocean.

As was required under the previous stormwater permit, this new permit requires the City to inspect certain businesses to ensure that they are complying with requirements, and that the appropriate Best Management Practices are being implemented. Your facility has been identified as one that may require inspection and or application for coverage under the permit guidelines.

The City has enlisted the services of CNC Engineering, Inc. to conduct these inspections. The consultant is visiting your facility to determine the type of business you are engaged in and the appropriate Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code for your facility. If the permit requires an inspection based on your SIC code, the consultant will be completing a checklist of permit and City Ordinance requirements. Your cooperation and assistance is necessary and appreciated. If necessary, the inspection may be scheduled for a future date.
