SUBJECT: Consideration of Amendment No. 3 to the Memorandum of Understanding

between the City of Industry and Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority for the SR 57/60 Confluence Project Westbound

Grand Avenue Slip On-Ramp

Background:

On November 23, 2011, the City entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority ("LACMTA" or "Metro"), defining the terms and conditions under which the SR-57/60 Confluence Project Westbound Grand Avenue Slip On-Ramp's ("Project") activities are performed and financed. The Project is Phase I of the larger SR-57/60 Confluence Project and includes the construction of a new westbound slip on-ramp and auxiliary lane, closure of the southbound Grand Avenue left turn lanes at the westbound SR-60 loop on-ramp and removal of the median along Grand Avenue to restripe a second southbound left turn lane to the eastbound SR-60.

Through Metro's 2009 Call for Projects, the City secured \$8.7 million in local Proposition C grant funds for a 50% share in project costs related to the right of way acquisition, construction and construction management. The remaining 50% share is expected to be funded in bond proceeds from the Successor Agency.

Metro implements a lapsing policy on all Call for Projects funding to ensure resources are provided for projects that can use them in a timely manner. The policy states that if programmed funds are not expended before their lapsing date, the grantee runs the risk of those funds becoming de-obligated for the entire project and therefore no longer being able to use them. Under the MOU, all funds programmed for: FY2011/12 were subject to lapse on June 30, 2014; FY2012/13 were subject to lapse on June 30, 2015; and FY2013/14 were subject to lapse on June 30, 2016.

On August 1, 2015, the City executed Amendment No. 1 to MOU P00F3137 to extend the lapsing date of funds programmed for FY2011/12 and 2012/13 to June 30, 2016.

With construction underway as of March 8, 2016 and the City having already requested reimbursement for early Project costs, the Metro Project Manager began working with the City to process a second amendment after the lapsing date of June 30, 2016. The locally managed Call for Projects funds are allowed some flexibility in the lapsing date dependent upon a positive demonstration of Project progress and expenditures. Processing a second amendment to extend the lapsing date allowed the City to keep their funding without having to appear before the Metro Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and requesting to do so.

On June 1, 2017, the City executed Amendment No. 2 to MOU P00F3137 to extend the lapsing date of the project funds to February 28, 2018.

Discussion:

A third amendment is necessary to reprogram \$2,800,000 of the funds from FY 2013/14 to FY 2017/18. These reprogrammed funds will be subject to lapse on June 30, 2020. This action enables the City to continue to expend Call for Projects funds. The Project is currently under construction with completion expected by November 2018.

It should be noted that the Metro Board adopted a Revised Lapsing Policy. The Revised Lapsing Policy limits projects to a one-time 20-month lapsing date extension from the last year of programming and eliminates interim lapsing dates.

Amendment No. 3 also includes the following revisions:

- Part I, Paragraph 2 of the existing MOU is being amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with language that incorporates the reprogrammed funds.
- Part II, Paragraph 8.1 (iv) of the existing MOU is being amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with language that incorporates the new lapse date for the reprogrammed funds.
- Attachment A of the existing MOU is to be replaced by Attachment A-1 which consists of an updated project funding breakdown.
- Attachment C-1 Scope of Work is to be amended by updating and replacing the Revised Project Schedule.

Fiscal Impact:

There are no costs associated with the third amendment.

Recommendation:

1) Staff recommends that the City Council approve and execute Amendment No. 3 to the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Industry and Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority.

AMENDMENT NO. 3 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CITY OF INDUSTRY AND

THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

This Amendment No. 3 to Memorandum of Understanding (this "Amendment"), is dated as of November 1, 2017, by and between City of Industry ("GRANTEE"), and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority ("LACMTA").

RECITALS:

- A. GRANTEE and LACMTA entered into that certain Memorandum of Understanding No. MOU.P00F3137 dated November 23, 2011, which was amended on August 1, 2015 and June 1, 2017 (as amended, the "Existing MOU"), which Existing MOU provides for the SR-57/SR-60 Confluence Project: Westbound Slip On-Ramp ("the Project"); and
- B. Whereas, LACMTA Board on July 27, 2017 approved reprogramming \$2,800,000 of the Funds from FY 2013-14 to FY 2017-18; and
- C. GRANTEE and LACMTA desire to amend the Existing MOU as provided herein.

AGREEMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Part I, Paragraph 2 of the Existing MOU is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following: "2. To the extent the Funds are available, LACMTA shall make to GRANTEE a one-time grant of Proposition C25% funds in the amount of \$8,751,425 ("the Funds") for the Project. LACMTA Board of Directors' action of September 24, 2009, granted the Funds to GRANTEE for the Project. The Funds were programmed over three years, Fiscal Years (FY) 2011-12, FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14. LACMTA Board of Director's action of July 27, 2017, approved reprogramming of \$2,800,000 of Funds from FY 2013-14 to FY 2017-18. Funds are programmed over four years, Fiscal Years (FY) 2011-12, FY 2012-13, FY 2013-14 and FY 2017-18."
- 2. Part II, Paragraph 8.1 (iv) of the Existing MOU is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following: "funds programmed from FY 2011-12 are no longer available. Funds programmed from FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14 are subject to lapse on February 28, 2018. Funds programmed for FY 2017-18 are subject to lapse on June 30, 2020."
- 3. Attachment A of the Existing MOU is hereby replaced by Attachment A-1, attached.

4. Attachment C-1 – Scope of Work, attached to the Existing MOU is hereby amended by deleting the Revised Project Schedule and replacing it with the following Revised Project Schedule:

Background:

City staff has prepared a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for EXPO Barn Lighting Design and Specification Services at the City of Industry EXPO Center. The Scope of Work includes new lighting for the 120 stalls, East and West barns, horse handling area, and the 18 stall wash racks adjacent to the West Barn. The RFP's objective is to select a Contractor to design an updated and energy efficient lighting system, develop equipment and material specifications, and establish a construction cost estimate.

Staff is recommending that the City Council approve publication of the RFP the City's PlanetBids web portal and to receive proposals for the EXPO Barn Lighting Design and Specification Services.

The scope of the RFP is as follows:

SITE ASSESSMENT AND PHOTOMETRIC STUDY

Provide photometric study of the existing barn's placement of lighting fixtures to assist in the upgrading, improving, and optimizing of lighting conditions to meet the specific needs of animals boarded in the barns.

Provide an assessment of existing barn electrical and lighting schemes and fixtures to determine criteria and technical parameters required for preliminary engineering.

DESIGN COMPLETION

Completion of the design and construction documents for a comprehensive updated barn lighting and switching system, horse handling area lighting, and wash rack stall lighting in order to provide improved and energy efficient lighting for the safe operation and care of boarded horses and animals.

SPECIFICATIONS AND BILL OF MATERIAL

Completion of the construction specification and compilation of a Bill of Materials and comprehensive construction cost estimate for the designed barn lighting and switching system, horse handling area lighting, and wash rack stall lighting as required for the complete planning and installation of materials and equipment (by others).

CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT

Contractor will provide construction support including the review of equipment and material submittals, resolution of Request for Information (RFI), review of Daily Reports, Test Data documentation, turnover materials, punch list items, and resolution of field issues as needed.

Fiscal Impact:

Staff is anticipating a project cost of approximately \$50,000. An appropriation will be requested at the time of award from the 2015 bond proceeds to Account No. 120.713.5130. No fiscal impact at this time.

Recommendation:

Staff is recommending that the City Council approve the publication of and receipt of proposals for the EXPO Barn Lighting Design and Specification Services on the City's Planetbids web portal.

The City constructed "East" and "West" barns at the EXPO Center's Equestrian Facility in 1985. These barns are 28,741 square feet each, with 120 - 12 ft. X 12 ft. stalls in each barn for the temporary accommodation of horses and livestock during annual rodeo and horse shows. A 40 ft. X 180 ft. horse handling area with 18 – 10 ft. X 10 ft. covered wash stalls also exist approximately 40 ft. south of the West barn.

Existing barn lighting consists of 4 ft. and 8 ft. 120v, pendent fluorescent lighting hung from the barn roof at various heights over the barn corridors and stalls. The horse handling area presently has sparsely spaced exterior lighting, while the horse wash stalls have no lighting.







Power Lighting Communication Plan (East Barn)





Power Lighting Communication Plan (West Barn)




Sheet E-4 Electrical Sections





Construction of East and West Horse Wash Stations at Industry Hills Equestrian Center




Sheet 2
Grading Plan – West Horse Wash Stalls




Sheet 3 Grading Plan – East Barn




EXHIBIT B

CITY OF INDUSTRY PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

This PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), is made and effective as of INSERT DATE ("Effective Date"), between the City of Industry, a municipal corporation ("City") and INSERT NAME OF CONSULTANT AND TYPE OF LEGAL ENTITY [i.e.-limited liability company, corporation, partnership, etc.] ("Consultant"). The City and Consultant are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, City desires to engage Consultant to perform the services described herein, and Consultant desires to perform such services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions herein contained, City and Consultant agree as follows:

TERM

This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date, and shall remain and continue in effect until tasks described herein are completed, but in no event later than INSERT DATE, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement.

SERVICES

- (a) Consultant shall perform the tasks ("Services") described and set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as though set forth in full. ("Scope of Services"). Tasks other than those specifically described in the Scope of Services shall not be performed without prior written approval of the City. The Services shall be performed by Consultant, unless prior written approval is first obtained from the City. In the event of conflict or inconsistency between the terms of this Agreement and Exhibit A, the terms of this Agreement shall prevail.
- (b) City shall have the right to request, in writing, changes to the Services. Any such changes mutually agreed upon by the Parties, and any corresponding increase or decrease in compensation, shall be incorporated by written amendment to this Agreement.
- (c) Consultant shall perform all Services in a manner reasonably satisfactory to the City and in a first-class manner in conformance with the standards of quality normally observed by an entity

providing INSERT TYPE OF SERVICES, serving a municipal agency.

- (d) Consultant shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances in the performance of this Agreement, including but not limited to, the conflict of interest provisions of Government Code Section 1090 and the Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000 et seq.)). During the term of this Agreement, Consultant shall not perform any work for another person or entity for whom Consultant was not working on the Effective Date if both (i) such work would require Consultant to abstain from a decision under this Agreement pursuant to a conflict of interest statute or law; and (ii) City has not consented in writing to Consultant's performance of such work. No officer or employee of City shall have any financial interest in this Agreement that would violate California Government Code Sections 1090 et seq. Consultant hereby warrants that it is not now, nor has it been in the previous twelve (12) months, an employee, agent, appointee, or official of the City. If Consultant was an employee, agent, appointee, or official of the City in the previous twelve (12) months, Consultant warrants that it did not participate in any manner in the forming of this Agreement. Consultant understands that, if this Agreement is made in violation of Government Code §1090 et. seq., the entire Agreement is void and Consultant will not be entitled to any compensation for Services performed pursuant to this Agreement, and Consultant will be required to reimburse the City for any sums paid to the Consultant. Consultant understands that, in addition to the foregoing, it may be subject to criminal prosecution for a violation of Government Code § 1090 and, if applicable, will be disqualified from holding public office in the State of California.
- (e) Consultant represents that it has, or will secure at its own expense, all licensed personnel required to perform the Services. All Services shall be performed by Consultant or under its supervision, and all personnel engaged in the Services shall be qualified and licensed to perform such services.

3. MANAGEMENT

City's INSERT STAFF RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PROJECT shall represent the City in all matters pertaining to the administration of this Agreement, review and approval of all products submitted by Consultant, but shall have no authority to modify the Services or the compensation due to Consultant.

4. PAYMENT

- (a) The City agrees to pay Consultant monthly, in accordance with the payment rates and terms and the schedule of payment as set forth in Exhibit B ("Rate Schedule"), attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as though set forth in full, based upon actual time spent on the above tasks. This amount shall not exceed INSERT WRITTEN DOLLAR AMOUNT dollars (\$) for the total Term of the Agreement unless additional payment is approved as provided in this Agreement.
- (b) Consultant shall not be compensated for any services rendered in connection with its performance of this Agreement which are in addition to those set forth herein, unless such

additional services are authorized in advance and in writing by the City. Consultant shall be compensated for any additional services in the amounts and in the manner as agreed to by City and Consultant at the time City's written authorization is given to Consultant for the performance of said services.

(c) Consultant shall submit invoices monthly for actual services performed. Invoices shall be submitted on or about the first business day of each month, or as soon thereafter as practical, for services provided in the previous month. Payment shall be made within thirty (30) days of receipt of each invoice as to all non-disputed fees. If the City disputes any of Consultant's fees it shall give written notice to Consultant within thirty (30) days of receipt of an invoice of any disputed fees set forth on the invoice. Any final payment under this Agreement shall be made within 45 days of receipt of an invoice therefore.

5. LABOR CODE AND PREVAILING WAGES

- Consultant represents and warrants that it is aware of the requirements of California Labor (a) Code Section 1720, et seq., and 1770, et seq., as well as California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Section 16000, et seq., ("Prevailing Wage Laws"), which require the payment of prevailing wage rates and the performance of other requirements on "Public Works" and "Maintenance" projects. If the Services are being performed as part of an applicable "Public Works" or "Maintenance" project, as defined by the Prevailing Wage Laws, and if the total compensation is \$15,000.00 or more, Consultant agrees to fully comply with such Prevailing Wage Laws. City shall provide Consultant with a copy of the prevailing rates of per diem wages in effect at the commencement of this Agreement. Consultant shall make copies of the prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to execute the Services available to interested parties upon request, and shall post copies at the Consultant's principal place of business and any location where the Services are performed. Consultant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless, the City, its elected officials, officers, employees and agents, from and against any liability (including liability for claims, suits, actions, arbitration proceedings, administrative proceedings, regulatory proceedings, losses, expenses or costs of any kind, whether actual, alleged or threatened, including legal counsel fees and costs, court costs, interest, defense costs, and expert witness fees), where the same arise out of, are a consequence of, or are in any way attributable to, in whole or in part, Consultant's or by any individual or agency for which Consultant is legally liable, including but not limited to officers, agents, employees or subcontractors of Consultant, failure or alleged failure to comply with Prevailing Wage Laws.
- (b) In accordance with the requirements of Labor Code Section 1776, Consultant shall keep accurate payroll records which are either on forms provided by the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement or which contain the same information required by such forms. Consultant shall make all such records available for inspection at all reasonable hours.
- (c) To the extent applicable, Cosultant shall comply with the provisions of Section 1777.5 of the Labor Code with respect to the employment of properly registered apprentices upon public works.

- (d) Consultant shall comply with the legal days work and overtime requirements of Sections 1813 and 1815 of the Labor Code.
- (e) If the Services are being performed as part of an applicable Public works or Maintenance project, then pursuant to Labor Code Sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, the Consultant and all subconsultants performing such Services must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. Consultant shall maintain registration for the duration of the Agreement and require the same of any subconsultants, as applicable. This Services set forth in this Agreement may also be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. It shall be Consultant's sole responsibility to comply with all applicable registration and labor compliance requirements.

6. SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

- (a) The City may at any time, for any reason, with or without cause, suspend or terminate this Agreement, or any portion hereof, by serving upon the Consultant at least ten (10) days prior written notice. Upon receipt of said notice, the Consultant shall immediately cease all work under this Agreement, unless the notice provides otherwise. If the City suspends or terminates a portion of this Agreement such suspension or termination shall not make void or invalidate the remainder of this Agreement.
- (b) In the event this Agreement is terminated pursuant to this Section, the City shall pay to Consultant the actual value of the work performed up to the time of termination, provided that the work performed is of value to the City. Upon termination of the Agreement pursuant to this Section, the Consultant shall submit an invoice to the City pursuant to Section 5 of this Agreement.

7. OWNERSHIP OF DOCUMENTS

- (a) Consultant shall maintain complete and accurate records with respect to sales, costs, expenses, receipts, and other such information required by City that relate to the performance of services under this Agreement. Consultant shall maintain adequate records of services provided in sufficient detail to permit an evaluation of services. All such records shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and shall be clearly identi–fied and readily accessible. Consultant shall provide free access to the representatives of City or its designees at reasonable times to review such books and records; shall give City the right to examine and audit said books and records; shall permit City to make transcripts or copies therefrom as necessary; and shall allow inspection of all work, data, documents, proceedings, and activities related to this Agreement. Such records, together with supporting documents, shall be maintained for a period of three (3) years after receipt of final payment.
- (b) Upon completion of, or in the event of termination or suspension of this Agreement, all original documents, designs, drawings, maps, models, computer files, surveys, notes, and other documents prepared in the course of providing the services to be performed pursuant to this Agreement shall become the sole property of the City and may be used, reused, or otherwise disposed of by the City without the permission of the Consultant. With respect to computer files,

Consultant shall make available to the City, at the Consultant's office, and upon reasonable written request by the City, the necessary computer software and hardware for purposes of accessing, compiling, transferring, copying and/or printing computer files. Consultant hereby grants to City all right, title, and interest, including any copyright, in and to the documents, designs, drawings, maps, models, computer files, surveys, notes, and other documents prepared by Consultant in the course of providing the services under this Agreement. All reports, documents, or other written material developed by Consultant in the performance of the Services pursuant to this Agreement, shall be and remain the property of the City.

8. **INDEMNIFICATION**

(a) Indemnity for professional liability

When the law establishes a professional standard of care for Consultant's Services, to the fullest extent permitted by law, Consultant shall indemnify, protect, defend and hold harmless the City and any and all of its officials, employees and agents ("Indemnified Parties") from and against any and all losses, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses, including legal counsel's fees and costs caused in whole or in part by any negligent or wrongful act, error or omission of Consultant, its officers, agents, employees or Subconsultants (or any agency or individual that Consultant shall bear the legal liability thereof) in the performance of professional services under this Agreement.

(b) Indemnity for other than professional liability

Other than in the performance of professional services and to the full extent permitted by law, Consultant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless City, and any and all of its employees, officials and agents from and against any liability (including liability for claims, suits, actions, arbitration proceedings, administrative proceedings, regulatory proceedings, losses, expenses or costs of any kind, whether actual, alleged or threatened, including legal counsel fees and costs, court costs, interest, defense costs, and expert witness fees), where the same arise out of, are a consequence of, or are in any way attributable to, in whole or in part, the performance of this Agreement by Consultant or by any individual or agency for which Consultant is legally liable, including but not limited to officers, agents, employees or subcontractors of Consultant.

(c) <u>DUTY TO DEFEND</u>. In the event the City, its officers, employees, agents and/or volunteers are made a party to any action, claim, lawsuit, or other adversarial proceeding arising from the performance of the services encompassed by this Agreement, and upon demand by City, Consultant shall have an immediate duty to defend the City at Consultant's cost or at City's option, to reimburse the City for its costs of defense, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in the defense of such matters.

Payment by City is not a condition precedent to enforcement of this indemnity. In the event of any dispute between Consultant and City, as to whether liability arises from the sole negligence of the City or its officers, employees, or agents, Consultant will be obligated to pay for City's defense until such time as a final judgment has been entered adjudicating the City as solely negligent. Consultant will not be entitled in the absence of such a determination to any

reimbursement of defense costs including but not limited to attorney's fees, expert fees and costs of litigation.

9. INSURANCE

Consultant shall maintain prior to the beginning of and for the duration of this Agreement insurance coverage as specified in Exhibit C attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

10. INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT

- (a) Consultant is and shall at all times remain as to the City a wholly independent consultant and/or independent contractor. The personnel performing the services under this Agreement on behalf of Consultant shall at all times be under Consultants exclusive direction and control. Neither City nor any of its officers, employees, or agents shall have control over the conduct of Consultant or any of Consultant's officers, employees, or agents, except as set forth in this Agreement. Consultant shall not at any time or in any manner represent that it or any of its officers, employees, or agents are in any manner officers, employees, or agents of the City. Consultant shall not incur or have the power to incur any debt, obligation, or liability whatever against the City, or bind the City in any manner.
- (b) No employee benefits shall be available to Consultant in connection with the performance of this Agreement. Except for the fees paid to Consultant as provided in the Agreement, City shall not pay salaries, wages, or other compensation to Consultant for performing services hereunder for City. City shall not be liable for compensation or indemnification to Consultant for injury or sickness arising out of performing services hereunder.

11. LEGAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The Consultant shall keep itself informed of State and Federal laws and regulations which in any manner affect those employed by it or in any way affect the performance of its service pursuant to this Agreement. The Consultant shall at all times observe and comply with all such laws and regulations. The City, and its officers and employees, shall not be liable at law or in equity occasioned by failure of the Consultant to comply with this Section.

12. UNDUE INFLUENCE

Consultant declares and warrants that no undue influence or pressure was used against or in concert with any officer or employee of the City in connection with the award, terms or implementation of this Agreement, including any method of coercion, confidential financial arrangement, or financial inducement. No officer or employee of the City has or will receive compensation, directly or indirectly, from Consultant, or from any officer, employee or agent of Consultant, in connection with the award of this Agreement or any work to be conducted as a result of this Agreement. Violation of this Section shall be a material breach of this Agreement entitling the City to any and all remedies at law or in equity.

13. NO BENEFIT TO ARISE TO LOCAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

No member, officer, or employee of City, or their designees or agents, and no public official who exercises authority over or responsibilities with respect to the Project during his/her tenure or for one year thereafter, shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in any agreement or subagreement, or the proceeds thereof, for work to be performed in connection with the Project performed under this Agreement.

14. RELEASE OF INFORMATION/CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

(a) All information gained by Consultant in performance of this Agreement shall be considered confidential and shall not be released by Consultant without City's prior written authorization. Consultant, its officers, employees, agents, or subconsultants, shall not without written authorization from the City, voluntarily provide declarations, letters of support, testimony at depositions, response to interrogatories, or other information concerning the work performed under this Agreement or relating to any project or property located within the City, unless otherwise required by law or court order. (b) Consultant shall promptly notify City should Consultant, its officers, employees, agents, or subconsultants be served with any summons, complaint, subpoena, notice of deposition, request for documents, interrogatories, request for admissions, or other discovery request ("Discovery"), court order, or subpoena from any person or party regarding this Agreement and the work performed there under or with respect to any project or property located within the City, unless Consultant is prohibited by law from informing the City of such Discovery, court order or subpoena. City retains the right, but has no obligation, to represent Consultant and/or be present at any deposition, hearing, or similar proceeding as allowed by law. Unless City is a party to the lawsuit, arbitration, or administrative proceeding and is adverse to Consultant in such proceeding, Consultant agrees to cooperate fully with the City and to provide the opportunity to review any response to discovery requests provided by Consultant. However, City's right to review any such response does not imply or mean the right by City to control, direct, or rewrite said response.

15. NOTICES

Any notices which either party may desire to give to the other party under this Agreement must be in writing and may be given either by (i) personal service, (ii) delivery by a reputable document delivery service, such as but not limited to, Federal Express, which provides a receipt showing date and time of delivery, or (iii) mailing in the United States Mail, certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the address of the party as set forth below or at any other address as that party may later designate by notice:

16. ASSIGNMENT

The Consultant shall not assign the performance of this Agreement, nor any part thereof, nor any monies due hereunder, without prior written consent of the City.

Before retaining or contracting with any subconsultant for any services under this Agreement, Consultant shall provide City with the identity of the proposed subconsultant, a copy of the proposed written contract between Consultant and such subconsultant which shall include and indemnity provision similar to the one provided herein and identifying City as an indemnified party, or an incorporation of the indemnity provision provided herein, and proof that such proposed subconsultant carries insurance at least equal to that required by this Agreement or obtain a written waiver from the City for such insurance.

Notwithstanding Consultant's use of any subconsultant, Consultant shall be responsible to the City for the performance of its subconstultant as it would be if Consultant had performed the Services itself. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed to create a contractual relationship between the City and any subconsultant employed by Consultant. Consultant shall be solely responsible for payments to any subconsultants. Consultant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties for any claims arising from, or related to, the services performed by a subconsultant under this Agreement.

17. GOVERNING LAW/ATTORNEYS' FEES

The City and Consultant understand and agree that the laws of the State of California shall govern the rights, obligations, duties, and liabilities of the parties to this Agreement and also govern the interpretation of this Agreement. Any litigation concerning this Agreement shall take place in the municipal, superior, or federal district court in Los Angeles County, California. If any action at law or suit in equity is brought to enforce or interpret the provisions of this Agreement, or arising out of or relating to the Services provided by Consultant under this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees and all related costs, including costs of expert witnesses and consultants, as well as costs on appeal, in addition to any other relief to which it may be entitled.

18. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the Parties relating to the obligations of the Parties described in this Agreement. All prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, representations, and statements, oral or written and pertaining to the subject of this Agreement or with respect to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, are merged into this Agreement and shall be of no further force or effect. Each party is entering into this Agreement based solely upon the representations set forth herein and upon each party's own independent investigation of any and all facts such party deems material.

19. SEVERABILITY

If any term or provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, then such term or provision shall be amended to, and solely to, the extent necessary to cure such invalidity or unenforceability, and in its amended form shall be enforceable. In such event, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such term or provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and each term and provision of this Agreement shall be valid and be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

20. COUNTERPARTS

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

21. <u>CAPTIONS</u>

The captions appearing at the commencement of the sections hereof, and in any paragraph thereof, are descriptive only and shall have no significance in the interpretation of this Agreement.

22. WAIVER

The waiver by City or Consultant of any breach of any term, covenant or condition herein contained shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such term, covenant or condition or of any subsequent breach of the same or any other term, covenant or condition herein contained. No term, covenant or condition of this Agreement shall be deemed to have been waived by City or Consultant unless in writing.

23. REMEDIES

Each right, power and remedy provided for herein or now or hereafter existing at law, in equity, by statute, or otherwise shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other right, power, or remedy provided for herein or now or hereafter existing at law, in equity, by statute, or otherwise. The exercise, the commencement of the exercise, or the forbearance of the exercise by any party of any one or more of such rights, powers or remedies shall not preclude the simultaneous or later exercise by such party of any of all of such other rights, powers or remedies.

24. AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE THIS AGREEMENT

The person or persons executing this Agreement on behalf of Consultant represents and warrants that he/she has the authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the Consultant and has the authority to bind Consultant to the performance of its obligations hereunder.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed as of the Effective Date.

EXHIBIT C INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Without limiting Consultant's indemnification of City, and prior to commencement of the Services, Consultant shall obtain, provide and maintain at its own expense during the term of this Agreement, policies of insurance of the type and amounts described below and in a form satisfactory to Agency.

General liability insurance. Consultant shall maintain commercial general liability insurance with coverage at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form CG 00 01, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$2,000,000.00 general aggregate, for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. The policy must include contractual liability that has not been amended. Any endorsement restricting standard ISO "insured contract" language will not be accepted.

Automobile liability insurance. Consultant shall maintain automobile insurance at least as broad as Insurance Services Office form CA 00 01 covering bodily injury and property damage for all activities of the Consultant arising out of or in connection with Work to be performed under this Agreement, including coverage for any owned, hired, non-owned or rented vehicles, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for each accident.

Professional liability (errors & omissions) insurance. Consultant shall maintain professional liability insurance that covers the Services to be performed in connection with this Agreement, in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per claim and in the aggregate. Any policy inception date, continuity date, or retroactive date must be before the effective date of this agreement and Consultant agrees to maintain continuous coverage through a period no less than three years after completion of the services required by this agreement.

Workers' compensation insurance. Consultant shall maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance (Statutory Limits) and Employer's Liability Insurance (with limits of at least \$1,000,000.00).

Consultant shall submit to City, along with the certificate of insurance, a Waiver of Subrogation endorsement in favor of Agency, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers.

Proof of insurance. Consultant shall provide certificates of insurance to City as evidence of the insurance coverage required herein, along with a waiver of subrogation endorsement for workers' compensation. Insurance certificates and endorsement must be approved by City's Risk Manager prior to commencement of performance. Current certification of insurance shall be kept on file with City at all times during the term of this contract. City reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, at any time.

Duration of coverage. Consultant shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property, which may arise from or in

connection with the performance of the Services hereunder by Consultant, his agents, representatives, employees or subconsultants.

Primary/noncontributing. Coverage provided by Consultant shall be primary and any insurance or self-insurance procured or maintained by City shall not be required to contribute with it. The limits of insurance required herein may be satisfied by a combination of primary and umbrella or excess insurance. Any umbrella or excess insurance shall contain or be endorsed to contain a provision that such coverage shall also apply on a primary and non-contributory basis for the benefit of City before the City's own insurance or self-insurance shall be called upon to protect it as a named insured.

City's rights of enforcement. In the event any policy of insurance required under this Agreement does not comply with these specifications or is canceled and not replaced, City has the right but not the duty to obtain the insurance it deems necessary and any premium paid by City will be promptly reimbursed by Consultant, or City will withhold amounts sufficient to pay premium from Consultant payments. In the alternative, City may cancel this Agreement.

Acceptable insurers. All insurance policies shall be issued by an insurance company currently authorized by the Insurance Commissioner to transact business of insurance in the State of California, with an assigned policyholders' Rating of A- (or higher) and Financial Size Category Class VI (or larger) in accordance with the latest edition of Best's Key Rating Guide, unless otherwise approved by the City's Risk Manager.

Waiver of subrogation. All insurance coverage maintained or procured pursuant to this agreement shall be endorsed to waive subrogation against City, its elected or appointed officers, agents, officials, employees and volunteers or shall specifically allow Consultant or others providing insurance evidence in compliance with these specifications to waive their right of recovery prior to a loss. Consultant hereby waives its own right of recovery against City, and shall require similar written express waivers and insurance clauses from each of its subconsultants.

Enforcement of contract provisions (non estoppel). Consultant acknowledges and agrees that any actual or alleged failure on the part of the City to inform Consultant of non-compliance with any requirement imposes no additional obligations on the Agency nor does it waive any rights hereunder.

Requirements not limiting. Requirements of specific coverage features or limits contained in this Section are not intended as a limitation on coverage, limits or other requirements, or a waiver of any coverage normally provided by any insurance. Specific reference to a given coverage feature is for purposes of clarification only as it pertains to a given issue and is not intended by any party or insured to be all inclusive, or to the exclusion of other coverage, or a waiver of any type. If the Consultant maintains higher limits than the minimums shown above, the City requires and shall be entitled to coverage for the higher limits maintained by the Consultant. Any available insurance proceeds in excess of the specified minimum limits of insurance and coverage shall be available to the City.

Notice of cancellation. Consultant agrees to oblige its insurance agent or broker and insurers to provide to City with a thirty (30) day notice of cancellation (except for nonpayment for which a ten (10) day notice is required) or nonrenewal of coverage for each required coverage.

Additional insured status. General liability policies shall provide or be endorsed to provide that City and its officers, officials, employees, and agents, and volunteers shall be additional insureds under such policies. This provision shall also apply to any excess liability policies.

Prohibition of undisclosed coverage limitations. None of the coverages required herein will be in compliance with these requirements if they include any limiting endorsement of any kind that has not been first submitted to City and approved of in writing.

Separation of Insureds. A severability of interests provision must apply for all additional insureds ensuring that Consultant's insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the insurer's limits of liability. The policy(ies) shall not contain any cross-liability exclusions.

Pass Through Clause. Consultant agrees to ensure that its subconsultants, subcontractors, and any other party involved with the project who is brought onto or involved in the project by Consultant, provide the same minimum insurance coverage and endorsements required of Consultant. Consultant agrees to monitor and review all such coverage and assumes all responsibility for ensuring that such coverage is provided in conformity with the requirements of this section. Consultant agrees that upon request, all agreements with consultants, subcontractors, and others engaged in the project will be submitted to City for review.

City's right to revise specifications. The City reserves the right at any time during the term of the contract to change the amounts and types of insurance required by giving the Consultant ninety (90) days advance written notice of such change. If such change results in substantial additional cost to the Consultant, the City and Consultant may renegotiate Consultant's compensation.

Self-insured retentions. Any self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the City. The City reserves the right to require that self-insured retentions be eliminated, lowered, or replaced by a deductible. Self-insurance will not be considered to comply with these specifications unless approved by the City.

Timely notice of claims. Consultant shall give the City prompt and timely notice of claims made or suits instituted that arise out of or result from Consultant's performance under this Agreement, and that involve or may involve coverage under any of the required liability policies.

Additional insurance. Consultant shall also procure and maintain, at its own cost and expense, any additional kinds of insurance, which in its own judgment may be necessary for its proper protection and prosecution of the work.

an amount not to exceed \$325,000.00

Background:

On September 20, 2017, the City began solicitations of public bids for the Tonner Canyon Zipline Construction project, as approved by City Council on August 10, 2017. This project was bid to procure a contractor to provide all required topographic surveying, geotechnical investigation, solar panel lighting for zipline area, and architectural and engineering design as required for construction of the zipline. The work included in the bid was to be inclusive of a fully functional zipline and include, but not be limited to anchoring systems, zipline poles take-off and landing platforms, platform access and egress routes, fall protection, platform foundations, zipline hardware and riding equipment (full body harness attached at center back with shock absorbing lanyard, helmets, gloves, etc.), and training manuals and training sessions for designated staff members. The bidder's scope of work also included a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan – SWPPP and complete removal of the existing zipline.

A Notice of Exemption ("NOE") was filed for the project on August 10, 2017. A copy of the NOE is attached.

The bid was posted on September 20, 2017 in the City's PlanetBids™ vendor portal and an email notification was sent to 140 registered vendors. The appropriate trade journals were notified on September 20, 2017 and included Bid America, Southern California Builders Association, Construction Bidboard and Dodge Data & Analytics. The bid was advertised on Monday September 25, 2017 and Monday October 2, 2017 in the San Gabriel Valley Tribune. Questions pertaining to the bid were received up until 4:00pm on October 18, 2017 via the City's PlanetBids vendor portal.

The bid process closed on November 3, 2017 at 11:00 A.M. Two (2) prospective bidders viewed the bid The Devlin Group Inc. dba Boulder Consultants, and MZN Construction.

One (1) bid was received from The Devlin Group Inc. dba Boulder Consultants. A review of the bid found that The Devlin Group Inc. dba Boulder Consultants submitted a responsible bid and has the relevant experience, qualifications and licensing necessary to complete this project.

Discussion:

The Engineer' Estimate for this project was \$220,000.00 for completion. The bid price of The Devlin Group Inc. dba Boulder Consultants was \$325,000.00. Several factors contributed to the bid being higher than estimated:

- 1. Ziplines are specialty projects with a limited number of qualified contractors.
- 2. There are very few local qualified zipline contractors in Southern California. The number of zipline contractors across the Nation is also limited. A number were notified of the bid once posted on PlanetBids.
- 3. The size of the City's zipline project would not be cost-effective for a non-local zipline contractor to submit a bid.
- 4. The project is located in a remote area and therefore it is at each bidder's discretion how much would be required to construct the zipline. While a contingency was included in the Engineer's Estimate, the recent wildfires which occurred October 18, 2017 along the 57 Freeway Tonner Canyon Road offramp during the bid period may have contributed to premium costs to cover their risk.
- 5. Only two bidders attended the mandatory pre-bid job walk. It is expected that when fewer than 10-13 bids are received that bid prices will be higher than estimated.
- 6. Bids included scope which was added to the bid package including topographical survey, solar panel lights, certification, training, equipment for users, and detailed estimating.

Fiscal Impact:

Appropriate \$325,000.00 from City's General Funds reserves – Tonner Canyon Zipline Construction (Account No. 120.714.5205).

Recommendation:

- City staff recommends that the City Council consider the results of the Tonner Canyon Zipline Construction bid and award the bid to The Devlin Group Inc. dba Boulder Consultants; and
- 2) Appropriate \$325,000.00 from City's General Funds reserves Tonner Canyon Zipline Construction (Account No. 120.714.5205).



Background:

On September 28, 2017, the City Council authorized solicitation of public bids for Contract No. 1444, Baldwin Park Boulevard and Amar Road Guardrail and Intersection Improvements project for an estimated cost of \$240,000.00. This project was bid to procure a contractor to construct a guardrail and a raised island at the intersection of Baldwin Park and Amar Road; a raised median on Amar Road; install calming measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speed; and install modified traffic signing and striping and signal phasing.

The bid was posted on September 28, 2017 in the City's PlanetBids™ vendor portal and an email notification was sent to 64 registered vendors. The bid was viewed by 23 prospective bidders. The appropriate trade journals were notified on October 4, 2017. The bid was advertised on October 4, 2017 and October 11, 2017 in the San Gabriel Valley Tribune. Questions pertaining to the bid were received up until October 24, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. in the City's Planetbids™ vendor portal.

Discussion:

The bid process closed on November 6, 2017 at 10:00 am. Five (5) bids were received from the following entities: All American Asphalt, EC Construction, Hardy & Harper, Inc., Wright Construction Engineering Corp., and Minco Construction. The review of bids has found that All American Asphalt has submitted the lowest responsive bid, and has the relevant experience, qualifications, and licensing necessary to complete this project. Below is a table of all bidders and their prices, showing that All American Asphalt is the lowest bidder.

The Engineer's Estimate for this project was \$240,000.00. The bid price from All American Asphalt was \$170,611.00 and was included in the4 2017-2018 Capital Improvement Program Budget. A 10% contingency has been included with the bid price to account for potential and unforeseen project changes, and a 10% appropriation for contract administration and inspection; total cost of the appropriation will be \$204,733.00.

Background:

On October 5, 2017, the City began solicitation of public bids for Agreement No. CIP-FAC-18-015-B, El Encanto Convalescent Hospital Roof Repair project for an estimated cost of \$25,000.00. This project was bid to procure a contractor to remove and repair the damaged roof structure and sheathing, roofing and flashing, patching of exterior stucco, interior and exterior painting, and removal and replacement of planter at the El Encanto Convalescent Hospital, 555 S. El Encanto Road in the City of Industry.

The bid was posted on October 5, 2017 in the City's PlanetBids[™] vendor portal and an email notification was sent to 77 vendors. The bid was viewed by 18 prospective bidders. The appropriate trade journals were notified on October 6, 2017. The bid was advertised on October 9, 2017 and October 16, 2017 in the San Gabriel Valley Tribune. Questions pertaining to the bid were received up until October 25, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. in the City's Planetbids[™] vendor portal.

Discussion:

The bid process closed on November 6, 2017 at 11:00 am. Three (3) bids were received from the following entities: Fisher Contractor, Inc., All American Contracting Corp., and GDL Best Contractors, Inc. The review of bids has found that Fisher Contractor, Inc., has submitted the lowest responsive bid and has the relevant experience, qualifications, and licensing necessary to complete this project. Below is a table of all bidders and their prices, showing that Fisher Contractor, Inc. is the lowest bidder.

The following table represents a summary of the bids received:

with PCC Pavement from Turnbull Canyon Road to Hacienda Boulevard, Project No. CITY-1421 with Sully-Miller Contracting Co., and Authorize the

City Engineer to Execute the Notice of Completion

Background:

On May 10, 2016, the City Council awarded Contract No. CITY-1421, Valley Boulevard Reconstruction with PCC Pavement from Turnbull Canyon Road to Hacienda Boulevard, in the amount of \$3,828,191.00 to Sully-Miller Contracting Co. This project replaces the existing asphalt concrete with new concrete pavement, adds new pedestrian ramps and includes new median drought tolerant landscaping.

On December 22, 2016, the City Council approved Change Order Nos. 1-4 as follows;

- Change Order No. 1: Adjust an existing traffic signal junction box in the existing median in Valley Blvd. at a cost of \$2,825.98.
- Change Order No. 2: Remove unsuitable and wet material during construction of the new curb and gutter and pedestrian ramps and place a layer of geogrid and additional Class II base material at a cost of \$2,714.88.
- Change Order No. 3: Reimbursed Los Angeles County Department of Public Works encroachment permit fees necessary to implement the traffic control in LA

County right of way at a cost of \$5,430.00.

• Change Order No. 4: Provide additional signs and striping and install glue down channelizers to safely separate east and west bound traffic at a cost of \$10,138.27.

On January 26, 2017, the City Council approved Change Order No. 5 as follows;

• Change Order No. 5: Remove interfering portions of an existing concrete reinforced concrete box (RCB) structure interfering with the new street section at a cost of \$3,438.13.

On August 10, 2017, the City Council approved Change Order Nos. 6-14 as follows;

- Change Order No. 6: Construct an 11.5 -inch reinforced concrete slab with footings on each side over an existing 16-inch diameter asbestos cement pipe ("ACP") located on the south side of Valley Blvd. from Turnbull Canyon and running easterly for approximately 600 lineal feet. This provided protection for the ACP waterline. The total cost totaled \$191,986.00.
- Change Order No. 7: Install glue down channelizers to safely separate east and west bound traffic under Phase 2 traffic control at a cost of \$5,543.04.
- Change Order No. 8: Grind the existing asphalt pavement in order to provide a smooth transition with the new lane under Phase 2 of the traffic control plan at a cost of \$6,759.70.
- Change Order No. 9: Install additional striping and pavement markers to assist motorists in navigating through the construction zone under Phase 2 of the traffic control plan at a cost of \$1,686.53.
- Change Order No. 10: Install rebar in the street section over an existing shallow storm drain and place a lean concrete mix as backfill at a cost of \$6,511.68.
- Change Order No. 11: Remove interfering portions of an existing concrete reinforced concrete box (RCB) structure interfering with the new street section under Phase 3 of construction at a cost of \$955.70.
- Change Order No. 12: Extend the transition from the new concrete pavement to the
 existing asphalt paving by grinding and repaving to achieve a smooth transition.
 Cost totals \$11,250.58.
- Change Order No. 13: Remove an additional 12-inches of wet, clayey and unsuitable material, install Tensar TX7 georgrid, replace with 12-inches of Class II

base and install an additional layer of Tensar TX7. The Contractor placed an additional 38,344 square yards of geogrid, removed an additional 6,295 cubic yards of unclassified excavation and placed 6,295 cubic yards of crushed aggregate base (Class II base) for an additional cost of \$686,738.50 of which \$240,000.00 will be paid under the contingency. Net additional cost is \$446,738.50.

• Change Order No. 14: Final field measurements included a credit of (\$103,858.50) for bid quantity underruns and an additional cost of \$117,118.50 for bid quantity over-runs. Total net additional cost is 13,530.00.

As of November 15, 2017, the City Engineer has determined that all work has been completed and the landscape maintenance period has terminated. CNC Engineering, Environs (landscape architect) and Kleinfelder (geotechnical engineers) have inspected the site and find all work complete and in accordance with the contract documents.

Discussion:

When projects are awarded and closed out the City must show a total project cost to include, but not limited to professional services such as: engineering (design and survey), traffic signal design, geotechnical, design support, construction management and utility coordination. The table below details the complete project costs for CITY-1421.

Fiscal Impact:

On May 10, 2016, the City Council appropriated \$3,828,191.00 to Project No. CITY-1421,

Valley Boulevard Reconstruction with PCC Pavement from Turnbull Canyon Road to Hacienda Boulevard which included a contingency allowance in the amount of \$240,000.00. On August 10, 2017, the City Council appropriated \$709,508.98 from the 2015 Sales Tax Revenue Bond Proceeds for Change Orders Nos. 1-14.

Total project costs is \$5,375,441.55, which includes design and construction management costs, landscape—architectural design costs, traffic signal design and geotechnical services. No additional appropriations are necessary.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. CC 2014-09, THEREBY DISSOLVING THE FULLERTON ROAD/GALE AVENUE/RAILROAD STREET

UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 8

BACKGROUND

On April 24, 2014, the City Council held a public hearing to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety or welfare required the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated service for the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/Railroad Street area of the City. Upon the conclusion of the requisite public hearing, the City Council adopted Resolution No. CC 2014-09 establishing an underground utility district for the area.

Pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. CC 2014-09, all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures were to be removed by March 16, 2016, and underground installations were to be completed no later than March 16, 2016.

To date, none of the removal of the poles, overhead wires or related overhead structures has occurred, and none of the undergrounding has commenced. Maintaining the Underground Utility District will cause significant delays to the Fullerton Grade separation project. It will also create the need for multiple property owners to upgrade their electrical facilities. Lastly, it will create significant hardships between the railroad and multiple utilities due to the railroad crossings that are required if the Underground Utility District remains.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:

Pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines, CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. The elimination of the underground utility district which was never implemented will not change the condition of the property. There was no conversion of the overhead utilities to underground, and no development was done within the district. The elimination of the district allows all properties to remain in their current state. Based on the foregoing, the dissolution of Underground Utility District No. 8 is exempt from CEQA. Staff is therefore recommending that the City Council adopt the Notice of Exemption and direct Staff to file same as required by law.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends the City Council adopt:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. CC 2014-09, THEREBY DISSOLVING THE FULLERTON ROAD/GALE AVENUE/RAILROAD STREET UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 8

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 12.20 of the City's Municipal Code ("Code"), the City is permitted to establish underground utility districts; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 12.20.020 of the City's Code, on April 24, 2014, the City Council held a public hearing to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety, or welfare required the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated service for the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/Railroad Street area of the City; and

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the requisite public hearing, the City Council adopted Resolution No. CC 2014-09 establishing an underground utility district for the area located within the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/Railroad Street area in the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. CC 2014-09, all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures were to be removed by March 16, 2016, and underground installations were to be completed no later than March 16, 2016; and

WHEREAS, to date none of the removal of the poles, overhead wires or related overhead structures has occurred, and none of the undergrounding has commenced; and

WHEREAS, maintaining the Underground Utility District will cause significant delays to the Fullerton Grade separation project. It will also create the need for multiple property owners to upgrade their electrical facilities. Lastly, it will create significant hardships between the railroad and multiple utilities due to the railroad crossings that are required if the Underground Utility District remains; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, City Staff is recommending that the City Council dissolve the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/Railroad Street Underground Utility District No. 8; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines, CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. The elimination of the underground utility district which was never implemented will not change the condition of the property.

There was no conversion of the overhead utilities to underground, and no development was done within the district. The elimination of the district allows all properties to remain in their current state. Based on the foregoing, the dissolution of Underground Utility District No. 8 is exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, notice of the City Council's November 30, 2017 public hearing concerning the dissolution of the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/Railroad Street Underground Utility District No. 8 was published in the San Gabriel Valley Tribune on November 17, 2017, and was mailed to all affected property owners as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and all concerned utilities on November 17, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2017 the City Council of the City of Industry conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the dissolution of Underground Utility District No. 8, and considered all testimony written and oral; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Findings. The City Council finds as follows:

- A. All the poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures were not removed and underground installations were not made Underground Utility District No. 8 by March 16, 2016 as required;
- B. There is not sufficient time now to establish Underground Utility District No. 8 without impacting the current Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/ Railroad Street project.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>CEQA.</u> Based upon independent staff analysis and in accordance with CEQA, this project is exempt per Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines. CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. The elimination of the underground utility district which was never implemented will not change the condition of the property. There was no conversion of the overhead utilities to underground, and no development was done within the district. The elimination of the district allows all properties to remain in their current state. Based on the foregoing, the City Council adopts the Notice of Exemption and directs staff to file same.

<u>Section 4.</u> Rescission of Resolution No. CC 2014-09. The City Council hereby rescinds Resolution No. CC 2014-09. The rescission of Resolution No. CC 2014-09 dissolves the Fullerton Road/Gale Avenue/ Railroad Street Underground Utility District No. 8.

<u>Section 5.</u> Public Notification. The City Clerk shall notify all affected utilities and all persons owning property within the former Underground Utility District No. 8 of its dissolution in accordance with the provisions of Section 12.20.090 of the City's Code.

<u>Section 6.</u> The provisions of this Resolution are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, sections, words or parts thereof of the Resolution or their applicability to other persons or circumstances.

SECTION 7: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and the same shall be in full force and effect.
