EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Expo Center:

For the month ended November 30, 2017, the Expo Center generated revenues of \$134,406 and incurred expenses of \$193,405. Transfers from the Capital Projects Fund amounted to \$51,793.

For the year to date ended November 30, 2017, the Expo Center generated revenues of \$800,796 and incurred expenses of \$1,082,111. Transfers from the Capital Projects Fund amounted to \$251,436. Year to date revenue and expenses are in line with the annual budgeted amounts.

Capital Projects Fund:

Total expenses budgeted for the year ending June 30, 2018 amount to \$330,675, which the Fund has incurred \$162,933 of actual expenses for the five months ended November 30, 2017.

DESCRIPTION OF REPORTS

The monthly financial statement is a comprehensive document reflecting the financial position of the Authority at November 30, 2017.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS NOVEMBER 30, 2017

CRIA Capital Assets

In accordance with GASB 34, the Civic-Recreational-Industrial-Authority (referred to as "CRIA") is required to capitalize and depreciate their capital assets. The capital assets net of accumulated depreciation at November 30, 2017 amounted to \$8,769,709. This amount represents the cost of capital assets purchased or constructed over the years at the Industry Hills Expo Center and surrounding areas. No depreciation expense has been recorded in the statement of operations for the period ended November 30, 2017. It is the accounting policy of the CRIA to record annual depreciation expense subsequent to the completion of the June 30, 2018 annual audit.

Capital Projects Operations

The capital projects fund reflects expenditures for capital improvements and operational costs. Operational costs include Board and staff salaries, professional services and miscellaneous items.
