5.1 UPDATE ON ACTIVITIES REGARDING COVID-19 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR INDUSTRY BUSINESSES AND RELATED INFORMATION, AND CONSIDERATION OF A PROCLAMATION AND ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDUSTRY, CALIFORNIA, PROCLAIMING EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt the Proclamation proclaiming existence of a local emergency and providing assistance to local businesses.

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City Manager Troy Helling provided a staff report by reviewing with the Council, the recommended updates to assistance programs for Industry businesses, in order to incentivize and motivate businesses to re-open. Staff is proposing that the City Council consider a process to allow for outdoor dining at all restaurants in the City, subject to certain regulations; a program that allows businesses in all zones of the City to hang temporary banners that will assist in advertising their businesses; and a reduction in development fees to alleviate the economic impacts of COVID-19 on businesses, and to help spur economic development in the City.
