Below for CRIA Board consideration is for the Industry Hills Expo Center to enter into the following License Agreements:

Licensee Agreement #MA-021316 – To enter into an agreement with Lynda Tjarks Agility Productions for a 3-day dog agility trials in the Grand Arena scheduled for February 13-15, 2016. The event consists of over 200 participants and 100 spectators. The base contract for this event is \$3,300. The balance of the fees is billed after the event as vendors, overnight RV spaces and arena lighting is calculated on what is utilized during the event. This promoter has added this additional event to our annual calendar. This promoter is a prompt payee.

Licensee Agreement #MA-050116 – To enter into an agreement with Lynda Tjarks Agility Productions for a 3-day dog agility trials in the Grand Arena scheduled for April 28 – May 1, 2016. The event consists of over 200 participants and 100 spectators. The base contract for this event is \$3,300. The balance of the fees is billed after the event as vendors, overnight RV spaces and arena lighting is calculated on what is utilized during the event. This promoter has added this additional event to our annual calendar. This promoter is a prompt payee.

Licensee Agreement #MA-062616 – To enter into an agreement with Classic & Kustom Bombs Magazine for a 1-day car show in the Grand Parking Lot scheduled for June 26, 2016. The promoter anticipates over 400 car entries and over 2,000 patrons to view the cars. This is the first event here for the promoter. The base contract for this event if \$1,556, which will be collected in full prior to the event. The Expo Center will retain all food, alcohol & parking income on this event.

Licensee Agreement #MA-080616 – To enter into an agreement with Southern California Oval Kart Club for a 1-day dirt kart competition in the Grand Arena scheduled for August 6, 2016. The event consists of about 150 participants and over 300 spectators. This is the promoter's third event at our site. Base contract is \$1,400. The Expo Center will retain all food, alcohol & parking income on this event. This promoter is a prompt payee.

Licensee Agreement #MA-110416 - To enter into an agreement with San Gabriel Valley & Antelope Valley Kennel Clubs for a three-day event scheduled for November 4-6, 2016 for their annual Obedience & Conformation Dog Show. This event consists of over 1,000 spectators in attendance each day. In addition to the use of the Grand Arena, the Vineyard is utilized for obedience. The basic rental rate for the Grand is \$3,300. Food, Beverages & Parking will be handled by the Expo Center and the balance of fees will be billed after the event is over as vendors, overnight RV hookups and arena lighting is calculated on what is utilized.

Licensee Agreement #MA-11116 – To enter into an agreement with Drum Roping Company for a two-day Veteran's Day Team Roping Benefit. This event is scheduled for November 11-12, 2016. Base contract is \$2,200. The Expo Center will retain all food, alcohol & parking income on this event. Promoter is a prompt payee.

Licensee Agreement #MA-042017 – To enter into an agreement with Angeles Canyon Dog Club for a four-day Dog Conformation & Obedience competition in the Grand Arena April 20-24, 2017. This event consists of over 600 participants and over 500 spectators each day. The base contract for this event is \$4,400. The Expo Center will retain all food, alcohol & parking income on this event. The balance of the fees is billed after the event as vendors, overnight RV spaces and arena lighting is calculated on what is utilized during the event. The promoter is a prompt payee.

## FINANCIAL STATEMENTS October 31, 2015

#### **Expo Center Operations**

During the month ended October 31, 2015, we held three events in the Pavilion and three events in the Avalon Room with contracts totaling \$27,735.

In the Grand Arena we held four events with contracts totaling \$48,031. These events were: Best of Show Classic Car Show-Event Rained Out, Industry Hills Charity Pro Rodeo 3-day rodeo events, Eclectic Roots Productions-Music, Art, Skateboarding, Bicycle Racing and Bier Buzz Masquerade-Craft Beer Festival

During the month ended October 31, 2015, there were no events at the Speedway.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS October 31, 2015

#### **CRIA Capital Assets**

In accordance with GASB 34, the Civic-Recreational-Industrial-Authority (referred to as "CRIA") is required to capitalize and depreciate their capital assets. The capital assets net of accumulated depreciation at October 31, 2015 amounted to \$8,769,709. This amount represents the cost of capital assets purchased or constructed over the years at the Industry Hills Expo Center and surrounding areas. No depreciation expense has been recorded in the statement of operations for the period ended October 31, 2015. It is the accounting policy of the CRIA to record annual depreciation expense subsequent to the completion of the June 30, 2015 annual audit.

### **Capital Projects Operations**

The capital projects fund reflects expenditures for capital improvements and operational costs. Operational costs include Board and staff salaries, professional services and miscellaneous items.
