Committee Member Steve Marcucci asked if one agency or corporation would be able to assist in all these items. Committee Member/Assistant City Manager Bing Hyun said yes, although sometimes they assemble teams with sub-consultants. He then asked who we use to put out bids. City Manager Josh Nelson said Planet Bids and if not enough proposals come back, there are other places to advertise if need be.

Committee Member Manuel Perez asked how we could add a public transportation component to link the Center to people in the Los Angeles County. Also, who will be evaluating these proposals? City Manager Josh Nelson said we have not gone that far

yet, but ultimately the City Council has the sole authority to award the proposed contract and may also amend the scope of services.

Sam Pedroza, Assistant City Manager, mentioned removing the lettering, "Financial Center", to just say "City of Industry" and add our current logo.

Bianca Sparks, Assistant City Attorney, said this was not on the agenda, therefore not up for discussion at this meeting but may be scheduled for a future agenda.

Discussion amongst the Committee Members pursued, and it was decided to look closely at option 4 and 5. It was decided to explore both options by contacting an architect for their input as well. Things to consider were the basic circulation of traffic to include truck turning templates with a possibility of doing a parking survey. This is not a final decision but an opportunity to look at the pros and cons of each site and to develop a master plan. The intent is to bring to the City Council in January 2023.
