Things to consider were the basic circulation of traffic to include truck turning templates with a possibility of doing a parking survey. This is not a final decision but an opportunity to look at the pros and cons of each site and to develop a master plan. The intent is to bring to the City Council in January 2023.

City Manager Josh Nelson mentioned he had already given an update and had nothing else to discuss.


COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS
