### **ACTION ITEMS**

#### **6.1 DISCUSSION AND DIRECTION REGARDING TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES THROUGH THE CIVIC CENTER**

*RECOMMENDED ACTION:* *Discuss and provide direction to Staff.*

City Manager Josh Nelson provided a staff report with slides and spoke on methods of calming traffic. The committee discussed traffic incidents on Nelson, adding medians on Hacienda to bring it to two lanes per side and installing bike lanes. Manny Perez suggested looking at traffic incidents on Nelson and how intersections affect pedestrians and bicyclists. Josh Nelson asked CNC to look at existing medians in the Civic Center, and how to connect to La Puente or Nelson and Glendora. CNC will also look at Rausch, Old Valley & Glendora intersections. It was agreed to start with calming traffic tactics first and if need be, more extreme measures after that. Josh Nelson said we will add one more line item to the budget for the CIP (Capital Improvement Projects).

### **COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS**

Committee Member Bing Hyun confirmed with Josh Nelson that CNC Engineering was doing a cost estimate on the Campus Design.

Chair Michael Greubel suggested for a future meeting the topic of underground electricity be discussed for the city for both safety and esthetics. It is very expensive but maybe we could do it little by little starting with the residential areas.


**ADJOURNMENT**
