OLD BUSINESS:

5. TRES HERMANOS RANCH PUBLIC ACCESS TOUR

RECOMMENDED ACTION: THAT THE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZE TRES HERMANOS CONSERVATION AUTHORITY STAFF TO CONDUCT PUBLIC ACCESS TOURS OF THE TRES HERMANOS RANCH.

Administrative Director Fox briefed the Board on the staff report, which is on file at the City of Chino Hills City Clerk's office. He stated that the tour of Tres Hermanos Ranch is tentatively scheduled for September 23, 2023, from 9:00 am. to 2:00 p.m. Four 25 participant tours will be offered to accommodate 100 total participants starting at the Diamond Bar Center on Grand Avenue with participants boarding one of two 25 passenger shuttles that will leave hourly at 9:00, 10:00 and 11:00 a.m., and 12:00 p.m. Stops will focus on the southern portion of the property and will include stops at the Arnold Reservoir, residence/barn, and Majestic Oak. Docents will be at each of the stops with information and to answer questions. Advance registration is required through the Authority's website and is on a first-come, first served basis. Registration is anticipated to be open in early September, likely after the Labor Day holiday. Liability and indemnification waivers will be required and those under 18 years of age will need to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Reasonable

accommodations will not be made under the American with Disabilities Act due to transportation limitations and tour occurring on a working ranch in a natural and unimproved setting without improvements, sidewalks, paths, and other amenities. Lastly, the tour is budgeted to cost approximately \$5,000, with \$3,000 to provide two shuttles and the rest for commemorative giveaways and miscellaneous items.

Discussion ensued on possible volunteer opportunities from Parks and Recreation Commissioners and part-time Recreation staff.

Vice-Chair Rogers inquired if local historian Paul Spitzzeri has been contacted for the tour and recommended reaching out to Dan Hostetler, retired Cal Poly Pomona Professor with specialty in agricultural education. Administrative Director Fox responded affirmatively and stated that he will reach out to Mr. Hostetler to check on availability and interest.

Director Marquez inquired on the location of cattle on the northside of the property and stated that proper coordination will need to occur with the Ranchers.

Director Chou asked if the reservation process will allow for each City to obtain equal reservations. Administrative Director Fox responded that all reservations will be made through the Authority's website which will include the waiver and will ask for the preferred tour time but we are unable to distinguish or limit by cities since it is open to the public on a first come and first served basis. Reservations are limited to one reservation per person.

Director Marquez asked to make sure water is available on shuttles during days with hot weather.

Jim Gallagher, resident, expressed his excitement for the tours and asked what goals and outcomes the Authority hopes to achieve as a result of the tours. Directors responded that they are hoping to provide education for the community and are wanting to respond to the community as they have been asking for an opportunity to tour the property even if it is on a small scale at this time.

Subject: Public Access Tour of Tres Hermanos Ranch Update

Recommendation:

Discuss and provide updates on the public access tour of Tres Hermanos Ranch.

Background/Analysis:

At the July 12, 2023, Tres Hermanos Conservation Authority (Authority) Board Meeting, the Board directed staff to develop a free public tour of the Tres Hermanos Ranch (Ranch) on September 23, 2023. The Ranch Tour will consist of four chaperoned tours, via 26-person shuttle-buses, to accommodate a total of 104 participants.

The Ranch Tours will originate at the Diamond Bar Center and last approximately 1.5 hours. Passengers will board 26 passenger shuttles leaving hourly at 9:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 12:00 p.m. Tours will include stops at the Arnold Reservoir, residence/barn, and Majestic Oak where docents will provide information about Authority, the history of the property, and plant and wildlife on the property. There will also be an opportunity for visitors to take pictures. Staff from the cities of Chino Hills, Diamond Bar, and the City of Industry have been working together to finalize the event program which includes securing transportation, arranging event docents with expertise relevant to the property, and developing event participant registration procedures.

On September 5, 2023, the online portal became available to the public for event registration through the Tres Hermanos Conservation Authority's website. Due to the overwhelming interest in the tour, there was a temporary disruption to the online registration process. Despite the disruption, the 104 available spots were filled through the online registration system within a few minutes of the registration form becoming available.

We received numerous event registration requests via email and phone calls subsequent to the closure of the website registration portal. There are approximately 400 individuals on the waitlist and waitlisted individuals will be placed on the event roster if space becomes available on a first come first serve basis established by the timing of their request.

Fiscal Impact:

The Authority's Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget does not include specific funding (giveaways, registration modifications, displays, brochures, trash containers, and refreshments for staff and participants) for the proposed event. However, sufficient funding exists in other program areas for the budget to absorb the proposed expenses, therefore, a budget amendment is not requested at this time. Authority staff will evaluate if a budget amendment is needed to cover these costs during the mid-year budget review process.
